We are currently seeking an energetic, enthusiastic professional to fill the following full-time non bargaining unit position:

Full-Time Live- In Maintenance Worker (Non Bargaining Unit Position)

The full time Live-In Maintenance Worker will support the housing and operations department as they work to provide healthy housing for clients with mental health disorders. This position will evolve and grow according to the successful candidate's interest and aptitude, and the housing and operations work flow needs. The Live-In Maintenance Worker will report directly to the Property Manager.

Responsibilities:

- Performs repair work to the units, building, grounds and equipment, which may be of an electrical, plumbing, mechanical and/or carpentry nature.
- Performs duties concerned with painting, plastering and repairs to floors, walls, ceilings including refinishing and repairs as assigned.
- Paint and decorate as and when required.
- Attend to breakdowns and take corrective action as needed.
- Perform basic building maintenance and repairs as required.
- Participate in and respond to after hours On-Call maintenance emergencies.
- Must comply with Occupational Health & Safety legislation.
- Work with the Manager to ensure that equipments and parts are ordered in a timely fashion and within budget.
- Complete assigned tasks in workman like manner and with minimal supervision.

Qualifications:

- Ability to use electrical hand tools including power drills, sanders, saws, gas powered lawn mowers and ladders. Knowledge of general repair and maintenance work and relevant work experience is required.
- Must possess excellent customer service and problem solving skills.
- Must have a valid Ontario Class "G" Drivers License, and a vehicle with adequate insurance coverage.
- Own tools to perform repairs would be considered an asset but not required.

This position is a full time non bargaining unit position working 37.5 hours per week. SHIP is an equal opportunity employer. Deadline for applications is Friday February 17, 2012. We offer an excellent benefits package and work environment. This position will also include a one bedroom apartment for the successful candidate to reside in.
